Students and Faculty

Covenant Classical Christian School is a racially, geographically, and socio-economically diverse student body. Students live in all areas of Columbia and the surrounding small towns. The faculty-to-student ratio is approximately 1 to 12. The average class size in the grammar school is 10 students; the upper school per grade level average is 13 students.

Graduation Requirements

Covenant Classical Christian School (CCCS) awards a college preparatory diploma. The program of study leading to graduation includes a minimum of 25.5 credits.

- 4 units of English
- 4 units of Mathematics including Algebra 1, Geometry and Algebra 2
- 3 lab Sciences including Biology, Chemistry, Physics
- 4.5 units of History including .5 credit for economics
- 1 unit of Rhetoric
- 3 units of a Foreign Language (Latin and/or a modern language)
- 1 unit of Physical Education
- 1 unit of Computer Science
- 1 unit of Logic
- 2 units of Bible
- 1 unit Fine Arts
- 10 hours of community service per high school year attended at CCCS

- 5 hours of Covenant Classical Christian School service per high school year at CCCS

Honors Courses

Covenant Classical Christian School offers honors credit for courses taken in English, Mathematics, History, Rhetoric, Sciences and Foreign Languages.

Class Rank

Class rank is not assigned to students graduating from CCCS. All students are enrolled in college preparatory classes and 100% are traditionally accepted to college upon graduation.

Grading Scale

Covenant Classical Christian School uses the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education Uniform Grading Scale for transcript purposes. Honors classes are weighted an additional 0.5 Grade Point Value.
