## HOME EDUCATOR'S LIAISON PROGRAM (H.E.L.P.) HIGH SCHOOL

### I. **PHILOSOPHY:**

Covenant Classical Christian School provides an instructional program that is based upon a Biblical world and life view. The mandate of Deuteronomy 6:6-7 places the responsibility of godly nurture and upbringing of children on the parents. CCCS seeks to assist parents with this responsibility by providing a Christ-centered education. This involves a well-rounded curriculum as well as a challenging atmosphere for learning. However, many parents may provide this type of atmosphere at home. Thus, CCCS will provide a support service to assist parents who have chosen to make the sacrifice and commitment necessary to teach their children at home.

### II. **ADMISSION:**

Parents must meet the admission requirements of the school, which include the following: interview, pastoral reference letter, payment of admission fee (\$25/student), and parent's signature on disclaimer form.

### III. **SERVICES PROVIDED:**

#### A. CLASSROOM ATTENDANCE:

Families may register for high school classes for the following fees.

\* Test scores/records are required for placement.

\*\* Not all electives are available each year.

\*\*\* For 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades we offer a combined 2 credit literature/history omnibus course, Ancient Civilization (9<sup>th</sup>) and Christendom (10<sup>th</sup>).

Core subjects (except for the omnibus classes) have a textbook fee of \$40 per subject.

Over two core subjects requires full-time tuition. A 10-month payment plan is available.

#### B. SCHOOL ACTIVITIES AND FIELD TRIPS:

- Various activities and field trips as scheduled during the year; however, not all field trips are open to homeschoolers.
- Checking out books from the school library will be limited to two books for a two-week period.
